

The jewelry collection called "Cycles" by artist and designer Kristyna Milde consists of hand made, individually crafted pieces. The design follows the organic principles of a living organism, where one form transits in to another. The name Cycles refers to the changing processes and forms in the nature. The layers of the translucent and opaque materials, gives the jewelry the unique luminous appearance inspired by X-ray photographs. The jewelry are made of cut outs from vinyl, which are stitched together with nylon thread. They are lightweight, durable and washable.

























Orange necklace, rigid vinyl, nylon, length 21 inches (53 cm)







